

## Lesson 84: John 12:42-50

### 1. Jesus' Teachings Concerning Good and Evil:

#### a. Teaching #7: Read v42-43.

- 1) Unbelievers may have \_\_\_\_\_ belief, but they will be ashamed to \_\_\_\_\_ Jesus as their Lord and Savior because they love the praise of \_\_\_\_\_ more than the praise of \_\_\_\_\_.
  - a) *Read* Romans 10:10-11.
  - b) Show me someone who is \_\_\_\_\_ to stand up and proclaim that he or she \_\_\_\_\_ in and \_\_\_\_\_ to Jesus Christ, and I will show you someone who has a major \_\_\_\_\_ problem.
- 2) Loving the praise of \_\_\_\_\_ more than the praise of \_\_\_\_\_ is a \_\_\_\_\_ that has \_\_\_\_\_ our entire country.
  - a) It causes clergy to \_\_\_\_\_ the Word of God, and it results in governments \_\_\_\_\_ sin, but most importantly it prevents people from getting \_\_\_\_\_.

#### b. Teaching #8: Read v44-45.

- 1) Belief in the Son \_\_\_\_\_ to belief in the Father.
- 2) How does one know whether he or she is worshipping the right God? (*Read* Mark 16:19, Hebrews 1:3 and 10:12)
- 3) Looking upon \_\_\_\_\_ is the same as looking upon the \_\_\_\_\_ (*Read* John 10:30 & Deuteronomy 6:4).
- 4) Those who refuse to believe that God the Father \_\_\_\_\_ His Son will refuse to \_\_\_\_\_ His Son, which in turn \_\_\_\_\_ them from being in the \_\_\_\_\_ of the Father.

**c. Teaching #9: Read v46-48.**

- 1) Jesus now teaches us that unbelievers send themselves to \_\_\_\_\_.
